**Additional Information:**

The Graduation-in-24-months rate of 23% was based on students who enrolled in the program between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015 and used Title IV federal financial aid.

Many of our students have chosen to take fewer credits in order to accommodate work and child care schedules and may not have graduated in 24 months. However, of those who started the program between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015, used Title IV financial aid, and completed the program, 97% graduated within 36 months.

Placement rates on the 2018 Gainful Employment Template are what was reported to our accrediting agency for the most recent ACCSC reporting period (2018) for April 2014-January 2015.

The EVT is filled out by the graduate after they have secured employment in the field and sent in to the Placement Office. This form is either mailed, emailed, or Facebook messaged directly to the Placement Office. If any further information is incomplete, the Placement Office will contact the employer by phone or email to verify information. Any verbal verification is documented with the employer's contact person, and is marked with the time and date and signed by the Bel-Rea Placement Director.*
