It is not always easy to know if someone has a learning disability. Here is some additional information to identify those in need of assistance.

- A learning disability is not limited to academics; a person can also be affected in social skills, emotional maturation, and motor coordination
- A person with a learning disability may be more emotionally sensitive and find it difficult to adjust to change
- A person with a learning disability may have deep fears of being found out, rejection, or judgement
- A person with a learning disability may have low motivation due to failure experiences throughout their life
