



Dr. Lonny Haynes Memorial Scholarship

Dr. Haynes was a Professor and the Assistant Dean of Education at Bel-Rea Institute of Animal Technology from 2001-2012. He taught Anatomy and Physiology I, Anatomy Lab I, Anatomy and Physiology II, and Veterinary Science III. He also trained the upper quarter veterinary technology students in surgical skills in the Pre-Clinical Rotations. Dr. Haynes was awarded Veterinarian of the Year in 2011 by the Colorado Association of Certified Veterinary Technicians. After retirement, he continued to contribute his support to Bel-Rea by joining our Advisory Committee.

Scholarship Description:

The Dr. Lonny Haynes Memorial Scholarship has been created to assist dedicated Bel-Rea veterinary technician students in achieving their educational goals. Two scholarships will be awarded per quarter in the amount of \$300 each to be used towards books and other supplies.

Scholarship Deadline:

Quarterly deadline is the first Monday of the month prior to the next quarter start (e.g., December 3rd, 2018 for the 2019 winter quarter).

Eligibility Requirements:

Bel-Rea students must be currently enrolled in 4th, 5th, or 6th quarter classes at time of application.

Application Evaluation:

Application submissions will be reviewed using a point system by a scholarship committee comprised of faculty and staff members. During the review process, applicant names will remain anonymous to eliminate the potential for bias.

Scholarship Recipients:
